THE 411 ON TEXAS811

811 is the national call-before-you-dig phone number. Texas811 offers free underground utility marking for planned excavations. Founded in 1984 and originally known as Dig TESS, this non-profit organization serves over 2,000 members, including utility companies and municipalities.

Available 24/7 by phone or online, Texas811 locates and marks underground utilities such as electric lines, telecommunication infrastructure, oil and gas lines, and water and sewer facilities. Whether you're planting a tree or laying the foundation for a skyscraper, it's crucial to call Texas811 before digging to avoid risks like personal injury, infrastructure damage, project delays, and service interruptions.

To use the service, simply **dial 811** or visit **texas811.org**. Lines are typically marked within two business days with flags along the located lines. Texas811 will coordinate with utility companies to mark buried lines in your project area, saving you the hassle of contacting each company individually.

White

Electrical Power Lines, Cables, Conduit and Lighting Cables



Red

Gas, Oil, Steam, Petroleum or Gaseous Materials



Yellow

Communications, Alarm or Signal Lines, Cables or Conduit



Orange

Irrigation and Slurry Lines, Reclaimed Water



Purple

Temporary Survey Markings



Pink

Sewer and Drain Lines



Green

Potable Water
