There are easier ways to pay. BTU offers many choices so you can find the bill payment option that fits your needs.







#### Automatic Bank Draft

Payment for your bill is automatically charged each month on the bill due date from the bank account provided.

#### Online E-Check

A one-time online transaction completed by the customer by entering information from a bank account into the secure portal on BTU's website.

#### Kiosk

Pay using cash, card or check at any one of our three convenient locations by entering your account number, listed on either your bill or your reminder letter, or by scanning a keycard provided by BTU. Keycards can be requested in the BTU main office.

#### Recurring Credit or Debit Card

A card that remains on file that is billed each month via a payment card industry (PCI) compliant process on your due date. This form of payment must be updated should your card expire or be cancelled.

#### Online Credit or Debit Card

A one-time online transaction completed by the customer by entering payment card information into the secure portal on BTU's website.

#### Interactive Voice Response (IVR) Phone

Payment is made by calling 979-821-5700 with a payment card and account number ready to enter into the automated system.



### CONSERVATION TIPS

#### **Energy Conservation Tip:**

Windows should be ENERGYSTAR® rated for our area of Texas or certified in all 50 states. ENERGYSTAR® rated windows are typically double paned and filled with gases to lessen radiant heat gain or loss.



#### **Water Conservation Tip:**

Standing water and saturated ground surrounding the water meter box could be indicators of a water leak. Other factors that should be considered include pooling water from irrigation and rain.
